



OLD VINE GEWÜRZTRAMINER 2010

Colour: Pale gold.

Aromatics: Lovely floral bouquet with rose blossom and jasmine and a hint of tropical fruit.

Palate: A delicate wine with refined notes of lychee and guava, sweet ginger spice and a touch of honey. An unctuous texture balanced by some refreshing acidity.

<i>REGION</i>	Gimblett Gravels, Hawke's Bay.
<i>VINEYARD</i>	Mere Road.
<i>VINTAGE</i>	A cooler year than average, which meant yields were down, however heat late in the season resulted in high quality fruit and good flavour development.
<i>HARVEST</i>	Hand harvested.
<i>ANALYSIS</i>	13%abv 10 g/l residual sugar
<i>OAK</i>	Partially fermented in French oak (unusual for this wine).
<i>VINIFICATION</i>	Crushed and de-stemmed with short period of skin contact then fermented in stainless steel followed by 2-3 months lees ageing.
