



SAUVIGNON BLANC 2011

Colour: Pale lemon.

Aromatics: Gooseberry, with notes of melon and lime.

Palate: Rich tropical fruit flavours of melon, mango and lime together with gooseberry. Tangy acidity complements the rich fruit and gives the wine a refreshing finish.

<i>REGION</i>	Gimblett Gravels, Hawke's Bay.
<i>VINEYARD</i>	Te Mata Woodthorpe.
<i>VINTAGE</i>	A wetter year than average, resulting in low yields. The fortuitous timing of the rain meant the quality of the fruit was not affected and the slower ripening season resulted in good flavour development.
<i>HARVEST</i>	Machine harvested.
<i>ANALYSIS</i>	12.5 % abv.
<i>VINIFICATION</i>	Fermented in stainless steel and aged on its lees 2–3 months.
